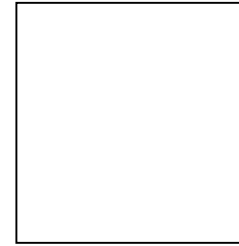


ANNUAL REPORT

The seminar was specifically targeted at the Airfreight Industry. The objective was to share with the companies the wealth of resources and assistance that IE Singapore can provide, in helping Singapore based companies internationalise.

Business Mission to Indochina from 12 August - 19 August 2004

Business mission to Indochina from 12 August – 19 August 2004 to promote Sea-Air Transshipment Cargo via Singapore. CAAS and IE Singapore led a business delegation of airfreight forwarders to Indo-China – namely Ho Chi Minh City (Vietnam), Phnom Penh (Cambodia), and Yangon (Myanmar) – with the following objectives:

- To provide the awareness of these Indochina countries about the availability of highly efficient facilities in Singapore for the transshipment of sea-air cargo.
- To explore possible collaboration and business tie-ups between Singapore companies and the local freight forwarders and shippers in these countries.
- To obtain an update on Indochina's economy, with focus on the garment and freight forwarding industries.

Social Activities

SAAA / ACCS Charity Golf 2004

The Singapore Air cargo Agents Association (SAAA) and Air Cargo Club Singapore (ACCS) jointly organised a Charity Golf Tournament on 28 July 2004 at the Garden Course, Tanah Merah Country Club.

The tournament raised a net sum of \$76,755.84 in aid of Ling Kwang Home for Senior Citizens (LKHSC). The sum which was the highest ever raised in the SAAA / ACCS Charity Golf Tournament, has enabled LKHSC to purchase an ambulance and some physiotherapy equipment.

SAAA / ACCS 5A Side Futsal Competition 2004

SAAA / ACCS organised the annual 5-a-side Futsal soccer Tournament on 22nd August 2004 at St. Wilfrid's Sports Complex. A total of 22 teams participated in the event.

SAAA Cargo Services Pte Ltd

SAAA Cargo Services Pte Ltd (SCS) was incorporated on 12 January 1988. It is a fully owned investment and neutral service arm of The Singapore Air cargo Agents Association (SAAA).

Amongst its diverse activities, SCS offers cargo clearance permit processing and Air Cargo EDI System (ACES) services. SCS's ACES and Tradenet Documentation office is located at the Singapore Airport Terminal Services (SATS) Airfreight Terminal 3, Core H.

SAAA's main objective in setting up SCS is to "advance and promote education and technical training in the air cargo forwarding industry and for such purposes to support training schemes."

SCS, as an authorised airfreight training school in Singapore offers many industry related courses comprising:

- IATA – FIATA Diplomas
- Air Freight Forwarders Basic Course
- Air Freight Forwarders Advance Course
- Dangerous Goods Regulations Initial Course
- Dangerous Goods Regulations Refresher Course
- Forklift Driver's Training Course

These courses are supported by the Skills Development Fund (SDF) Training Grant Training Voucher Scheme.

CargoTec Pte Ltd

A joint venture between SAAA Cargo Services Pte Ltd, Airtruck Services Pte Ltd and Allspeed Services Pte Ltd, CargoTec commenced business on 1st April 2003. CargoTec, an independent third-party service provider is an alternative with a difference to serve the air cargo industry.
